Just bake your favorite cupcake and use your favorite frosting. Make May Poles using Pirouette cookies and ribbon. Attach the ribbon underneath the top of the May Pole using a dab of left over Royal Icing but you could use Karo Syrup.

The top of the May Pole is a flavored tootsie roll, but you could just as easily use a piece of fondant or spiced gum drop.
